Emergency Department Charges

Emergency Department charges are based upon the level of emergency care provided to our patients. The levels, with level 1 representing basic emergency care, reflect the type of accommodations needed, the personnel resources, the intensity of care and the amount of time needed to provide treatment. The following levels of care do not include fees for drugs, supplies, or additional ancillary procedures that may be required for emergency treatment. The hospital does not bill for the emergency room physicians - the patient will receive a separate bill from Alteon Physicians for the Physician Charge.

Surgical Center Charges

Surgical charges are classified by specialty, type of procedure, equipment, instrumentation, supplies and staffing. There is an initial surgery charge based upon the classification determined, which includes the first 30 minutes of surgery, as well as a charge for each additional minute until the operation is complete. The following charges do not include charges for anesthesia, recovery room, medications, implants, pathology and patient-specific supplies used during the procedure.
